How to Get Here

FLIGHTS

NIHI's Bali office can assist in arranging domestic flights and ticketing between Denpasar (DPS), Bali and Tambolaka (TMC), the closest airport to NIHI Sumba. There is also a direct flight from Surabaya (SUB) to Tambolaka three times a week, on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

DEPARTURE TAX

If return flights from Bali to Sumba are booked through NIHI, all domestic airport taxes are included in the rate.

TRANSFERS

Transfers from Tambolaka airport to NIHI take approximately 90 minutes. Private option is available depending on capacity.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Visitors from the USA, Canada, UK, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, China, and India can typically obtain an Indonesian visa on arrival, allowing a 30-day stay. If not eligible, embassy applications are an option. Ensure passports are valid for at least six months upon arrival with a clean visa page to avoid boarding denial in the departing country.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Malaria has decreased by 93% in nearby areas, but we maintain precautions, regularly misting the resort. Villas include mosquito nets, and we offer repellent in all rooms. Consult your GP about prophylactics. Local clinics and a hospital are within a 45-minute drive. Stay current on your vaccines.

DRESS CODE

Between 1988 and 1994, life on Sumba Island was challenging, with no running water, electricity, or medical care. Malaria was rampant, affecting both villagers and newcomers. Nihiwatu's founder Claude Graves, and his family, founded The Sumba Foundation®, embodying his vision to uplift the community. Chris Burch continued the legacy by founding the Burch Family Foundation to support all philanthropic projects related to the community in Sumba.

THE SUMBA FOUNDATION

A constantly evolving organization to meet the current and future needs of the Sumbanese people, building a solid foundation of better health and basic education for the community, creating employment and small-scale business opportunities for future generations.

KUDA HERITAGE PROJECT

Supported by the Burch Family Foundation, this monthly initiative brings essential veterinary care, hoof treatment, parasite control, and wellness checks, to horses in remote Sumbanese villages. Led by Doc Osta and the NIHI Stables team, it also provides mentorship for local youth, nurturing equine knowledge and empowering the next generation of compassionate caretakers.

SUMBA HOSPITALITY FOUNDATION

Sumba was poised for a surge in tourism development, with potential to create indispensable job opportunities. Many Sumbanese youth did not have access to the relevant education, and that's how Inge founded the Sumba Hospitality Foundation.

ENGLISH GOES TO KAMPUNG

A grassroots organization founded by English teacher and activist, Roswita Asti Kulla. Recognizing education as a vital tool to alleviate poverty and gain access to job opportunities, EGK's mission is to make education more widely accessible on Sumba Island.

NIHI® ROTE & HOSPITALITY ACADEMY

At Indonesia's south-eastern corner, NIHI Rote rises quietly.

Opening in 2026, NIHI Rote rises at Indonesia's south eastern edge as an intimate island world where ocean, culture and purpose converge. Built around the NIHI Rote Hospitality Academy, guests arrive at a living school where young Rotenese and Timorese talent train in real time, guided by Michael Schwab and shaped with Nobel Peace Prize Laureate President José Ramos-Horta, making it the first resort of its kind in Indonesia.

In its opening year, guests and students evolve together through small acts of shared learning, creating a rare luxury of meaning. Twenty one expansive villas line Bo'a Beach in Rotenese architecture with open living spaces and uninterrupted ocean views, complemented by uncrowded surf, diving, fishing, village exploration, wellness and state of the art fitness.


